Arrows

When entering the tournament you are declaring that you will comply with the Rules of Shooting of Archery GB, including dress regulations, and that you are a current member of Archery GB or a recognised governing body. Proof of membership may be required at registration.

Photography:

Archers with disabilities or special requirements are asked to inform the Tournament Organiser when entering so suitable arrangements can be made.
